California Women's Chorus, Inc. Music Scholarship Rules and Regulations

Applicant must read and sign acceptance on their application.

Scholarships awarded by the California Women's Chorus, Inc. and/or any subordinate chorus shall conform to the 501c(3) requirements and be in keeping with the purposes of the California Women's Chorus, Inc. The following rules and regulations shall be followed in awarding scholarships.

1. Scholarships shall be awarded based on musical merit to individuals seeking to further their musical education and training.
2. No member, relative of a member, or substantial contributor shall benefit from the scholarship fund nor serve on a panel that will judge any family member of the chorus or California Women's Chorus, Inc. No adjudicator may judge a member of his/her family.
3. All scholarship winners shall be allowed to win a California Women's Chorus, Inc. scholarship one time only. Recipients of Honorable Mention awards may compete for and receive a future CWC scholarship.
4. The selection of scholarship recipients by the CWC or any subordinate chorus shall be done by an impartial panel selected for this purpose. The selection committee may be made up of members of the CWC, Inc. or outside individuals.
5. Scholarships shall be paid directly to the recipient provided that the scholarship will be used to pay the actual expenses of furthering the recipient's musical education and training.
6. Any individual receiving the scholarship who uses the funds for purposes other than furthering their musical education and training shall be deemed to have committed fraud and the CWC shall seek appropriate remedies through state or federal law.
